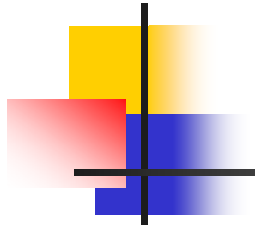

- **Social Science as History**
- What follows is a historical study of intellectuals and the social sciences, or better, of the intellectual as social scientist, in Japan from the 1890s roughly to the present. But I wish to begin with a Russian parable based on a minor character in a novel by Leo Tolstoy.
- The novel is *Anna Karenin*, the character is Sergei Ivanich Koznyshev. Koznyshev is a city intellectual, a social type of whom Tolstoy was none too fond. Unlike his half-brother Konstantin Levin, Koznyshev takes the institution of the *zemstvo* land assembly seriously, even, on occasion, upbraiding the great landowner and spiritual pilgrim for ignoring his political responsibilities. This, we are shown, is somewhat unfair to Levin. Not only does Levin write a book on the problem of Russian agriculture, even more, in his vision...
